If you only have a 'lot number' for your place, you should contact the county assessor for a 'physical address' and then ask to be added to the 'e-911 system.' It's hard to find houses out here. Please make it easier for emergency responders to find you and shave off time for help to arrive. Consider putting a reflective house number sign at the beginning of your driveway at the road.

PHI Cares - Medivac Helicopter

The reality is that for serious medical problems, the EMS team will fly patients to ABQ. Socorro is a basic hospital and so often more complicated cases are then sent to ABQ anyways. The county is currently providing coverage (from Catron County) for free. PHI provides a membership fee of \$50/family/YEAR if you have insurance and about \$100 if you have no insurance for coverage anywhere they fly. In that agreement, they will not come after you for any additional amount of money should they transport you. The cost to ABQ is about \$70,000.00 from out here.

Trash & Recycling

There are a few transfer stations in the county. Datil & Quemado require an annual permit from the county and a minimum dump fee per trip that is weight based. Pie Town has a fee per bag which is often cheaper than the county but the county fee keeps it open for everyone and hopefully reduces illegal dumping. Only Quemado and Reserve take construction waste, the others are for household waste (fairly widely defined, but you know when it's really construction waste).

Dumpsters can be rented from the county for a roll-off dumpster.

Internet

Several options.

Verizon - We were fairly pleased by using Verizon data for our internet needs when we first arrived. It was (is?) cheaper to add more data to a phone we already had than it was to add a new service such as dsl/satellite. Verizon has good coverage out here and had very good uptime for the phone and internet.

Western New Mexico offers DSL.

Direct TV offers slower satellite internet

Starlink offers faster internet - currently ~400mbps down and ~27mbps up. It is more expensive but much faster. You need to buy the equipment for an upfront cost and about \$120/month. We have had rare, brief interruptions. Less than on the rare and mostly brief interruptions with Verizon. Use this link, if you wish, for one month free and I get one month free as well:
